### Description

The Alzheimer Society Research Program (ASRP) provides grants and awards to support Canadian research that promises new insights into causes, prevention, diagnosis, treatment and management of Alzheimer's disease and other dementias.

The Proof of Concept Grants are designed to fund innovative, high-risk and high-reward research that pushes beyond the boundaries of our existing understanding of dementia. Interested researchers must first submit a LOI. When deemed eligible they are invited to submit a full application.

# Eligibility

Principal investigators must hold a position equivalent to the rank of Assistant Professor or higher in a Canadian research-intensive University. Adjunct professors at or above the level of Assistant Professor are eligible to apply.

The Proof-of-Concept Grants program will favour those applications that focus on challenging new directions in research into Alzheimer's disease and other dementias.
