Description

Swine Innovation Porc (SIP) is a national organization that consists of nine members, including the Canadian Pork Council and eight provincial pork organizations. The main goal of SIP is to be recognized as the 'go to' organization in Canada that facilitates swine-related research and knowledge transfer initiatives. SIP supports the renewal of another Canadian Agri-Science Clusters Initiative, part of AAFC's next agricultural policy framework. In the anticipation of another potential round of funding, SIP is currently putting together the five-year Swine Cluster 3 research program covering the period of 2018-2023.

This call for LOIs will allow the research community to submit innovative and integrated projects that will be relevant and beneficial to the competitiveness, profitability and sustainability of the pork industry. In this regard, projects in any field are encouraged. However, preference will be given to LOIs that fall within research priorities identified by Swine Innovation Porc.

- Promote multi-disciplinary and multi-institutional collaborative efforts that significantly impact the success of Canada's swine industry.

How to Apply

This is a two stage application process:

1. Letters of intent (LOI). Researchers must complete and submit the LOI no later than January 20, 2017 at 11:00 p.m. Pacific Time (or January 21, 2017 at 1:59 a.m. Eastern

Time) in accordance with the sponsors submission instructions. Researchers are not required to submit their LOI to the Office of Research for approval before submission to the sponsor. Researchers are asked to send a copy of their proposal to the Office of Research for information purposes only (no OR-5 required at the LOI stage). Researchers will be notified by the sponsor by March 2017 if they have been invited to submit a full proposal.

2. **Full Proposal.** Those invited to submit a full proposal must submit the proposal, along with an OR-5 to the Office of Research two weeks in advance of the sponsor's deadline. The sponsors tentative deadline for submission of full detailed proposals is May 2017.
