Description

The Canada Council for the Arts Molson Prizes are awarded to two persons – one in the arts and the other in the social sciences and humanities, who have distinguished themselves by their outstanding achievements. The prizes are intended to encourage ongoing contributions to Canada's cultural and intellectual heritage.

Program details and timeline are not yet confirmed. This information will be updated when the program launches.

Eligibility

Must be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident of Canada. Candidates do not need to be residing in Canada.

Candidates must be nominated by one nominator; either an individual or an organization. Anyone or any organization with an interest in, and capacity for nominating appropriate individuals is eligible to do so.?

To be nominated, candidates must have made a substantial and distinguished contribution over a significant period. In the words of the deed of the gift, the prizes are intended “to encourage Canadians of outstanding achievement in the fields of the arts, the humanities or the social sciences to make further contribution to the cultural or intellectual heritage of Canada.”

Self-nomination is not permitted.

Prize

Two prizes valued at up to \$50,000 each.
