The Canadian Frailty Network (CFN) is looking to fund knowledge translation and real-world implementation proposals aimed to empower remote Indigenous communities to enable them to improve care for, and support their elders to remain in their home or communities. Proposals must focus on the scale or spread of a prior health and/or social care initiative shown to be effective in a smaller context.
