# **Eligibility**

- Only projects led by **PIs who have never collaborated before** will be considered.
- PhD candidate and individuals holding postdoctoral positions are not eligible as Pls.

- Canadian PIs must be from on of the 21 Canadian member universities of the FCRF.
- Teams not selected in previous editions Canadian that wish to apply again must inform the Embassy of France in Canada at the time of submitting their new application (there is a limit of one second application).

Award amounts range from \$8,000 to \$15,000 CDN.

90% of the funding awarded will support mobility of researchers and students affiliated with the project.
