The New Scientific Collaboration Support Program, financed by the France-Canada Research Fund (FCRF), aims to accomplish the following objectives:

- support developing new expert partnerships between France and Canada
- promote the advancement of research and innovation
- prepare and structure scientific cooperation between the two countries
- promote researcher mobility, particularly for young researchers
- provide research training for young researchers

NEW: The 2023 edition will offer two priority themes:

- "Healthy aging in our societies: A cross perspective of social sciences and technologies"
- "Energy transition: New technologies with a societal impact "

Eligibility

- Only projects led by **PIs who have never collaborated before** will be considered.
- PhD candidate and individuals holding postdoctoral positions are not eligible as Pls.

- Canadian PIs must be from on of the 21 Canadian member universities of the FCRF.
- Teams not selected in previous editions Canadian that wish to apply again must inform the Embassy of France in Canada at the time of submitting their new application (there is a limit of one second application).

Maximum Project Value

Award amounts range from \$8,000 to \$15,000 CDN.

90% of the funding awarded will support mobility of researchers and students affiliated with the project.

Both PIs must fill-in the application form (See "File Attachments" below for the form):

- Answer the eligibility questions and secondary questions .
- Select the scientific field(s). Please check the 2023 specific theme box if applicable.
- Fill in sections 1 to 8.
- Provide the CVs of the team members involved in the project (maximum 4 CVs). The CVs must summarize research activities for the last 10 years, including the most representative publications, conferences, awards and distinctions, as well as the supervision of early stage researchers.
