# **Eligibility**

Criteria of eligibility:

- The research projects of the selected applicant must be part of a 2018 Franco-Canadian research project preselected by the FCRF's Canadian member universities.
- The selected applicant must hold Canadian citizenship.
- The applicant's research projects must make positive contributions to the vitality of scientific cooperation between France and Canada.

### **Maximum Project Value**

\$8,000 to \$15,000, according to the needs expressed by the principal investigators.

Two years
