Description

Ontario Centres of Excellence (OCE) launched the second round of a program being delivered on behalf of the Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care and as part of the [Office of the Chief Health Innovation Strategist's](#) [1] (OCHIS) mandate to strengthen Ontario's health innovation system.

The [Health Technologies Fund \(HTF\)](#) [2] supports the development of made-in-Ontario health technologies by accelerating evaluation, procurement, adoption and uptake across the Ontario health system.

The health priority area for the HTF is **Better Care Closer to Home**, which supports technologies that deliver better coordinated and integrated care in the home and community. Projects must be led by a publicly-funded healthcare service provider and include a Problem Statement that supports Pre-Market Evaluation or Early Adoption of an innovative technology.
