The **Lasker Awards** program was created in 1945 by Albert and Mary Lasker to shine a spotlight on fundamental biological discoveries and clinical advances that improve human health, and to draw attention to the importance of public support of science. The Foundation will begin accepting nominations for the 2023 Lasker Awards late in the year.

## **Eligibility**

Anyone who has made an original and significant contribution in basic or clinical medical research, or in public service, is eligible for nomination. Lasker Awards are highly competitive and are bestowed on individuals whose work opens new areas of biomedical science. Award winners may reside in any country of the world.

Colleagues familiar with the nominee(s)'s work and with the relevant field of research are ideal nominators. Self-nominations or nominations written by the candidates themselves will not be considered by the Jury.

#### **Prize**

The Lasker Awards carry an honorarium of \$250,000 for each category.
