Description

The **Millennium Technology Prize** is Finland's tribute to innovations for a better life.

The Prize highlights the extensive impacts of science and innovation on society, even on humanity at large.

General principles of the Millennium Technology Prize:

- Awarded to **technological innovations that enhance the quality of people's lives** in a sustainable manner.
- The innovations have been **applied in practice** and are delivering extensive change now and in the future.
- The innovations **stimulate further cutting edge research and development** in science and technology.

The Millennium Technology Prize encourages further cutting-edge research and development and is thus not intended as a reward for lifetime achievement. The Prize also highlights the Finnish practical and solution-focused mindset – one of the greatest strengths of Finland – to the whole world.

Eligibility

Candidates for the Prize are accepted from across the world and all fields of technology excluding military technology. Nominations are invited from organizations such as universities, research institutes, academies of science and technology, companies and industries.

Self-nominations are not accepted.

Prize

The Prize is worth one million euros and it is awarded every second year.
