Description

The Species at Risk Stewardship Program (SARSP) includes the former Species at Risk Stewardship Fund (SARSF) as well as the Species at Risk Research Fund for Ontario (SARRFO): The objectives of the SARSP are:

- Improving the status of species at risk and their habitats by supporting stewardship and recovery actions
- Supporting stewardship and multi-partner approaches to species at risk protection and recovery
- Supporting outreach, youth employment opportunities and the provision of related tools and techniques to inspire and enable people to become involved in species at risk stewardship
- Addressing important needs and knowledge gaps related to the protection, recovery and management of species at risk and their habitats in Ontario by supporting scientific research

Although all project proposals that target species listed on the Species at Risk in Ontario List are eligible for consideration, targeted priorities have been established for the 2020-2021 funding year. Please review the <u>2020-21 priorities</u> [2] in detail. Applications that fail to address any of the 2020-2021 priorities will be considered for funding after applications that address priorities. For 2020-2021, where possible and feasible, we are encouraging applicants, to submit broad, strategic, consolidated multi-partner project proposals.

For 2020-2021, the SARSP is accepting multi-year applications (spanning 1-3 fiscal years) that support stewardship initiatives and contribute to the protection and recovery of species at risk in Ontario. All project activities must begin no earlier than April 1, 2020 and finish no later then March 1 for each fiscal year of the project.
