Description

The Mitacs Accelerate Fellowship provides a long-term funding and internship option for Master's and PhD students. Recipients can also access professional development training that helps them ensure project success and gain in-demand career skills. Students work closely with a partner organization and faculty supervisor, using the latest tools and techniques available to them in both academic and industrial settings. Projects are a cost-shared model with Mitacs, through the support of federal and provincial government, matching the industry partners or nonfor-profit (NFP) organizations dollar for dollar.

The expectations for the internships are as follows:

- Spend 50% of the internship with the university and 50% with the partner organization
- Submit a final report and exit survey summarizing project results and experiences
- Follow the Accelerate Code of Conduct

Interested applicants can <u>apply for the Accelerate Fellowship at any time</u> [2]. All other Accelerate program guidelines apply.
