- Faculty applicants may submit an application for undergraduate awards and
 a <u>separate</u> application for the graduate award. If you submit the same project for both
 undergraduate and graduate awards, you <u>must</u> clearly explain the roles of students,
 differentiating between an undergraduate summer research experience and graduate
 study.
