To address this need, the Canadian Space Agency (CSA) is currently working on establishing the framework for a Technology Demonstration Program that will support demonstration activities from ground to space.

To support this initiative, the SS&T directorate invites you to provide your opinion and comments through a Request for Information (RFI).

Understanding Technology Demonstration

Technology demonstration, for the purpose of the demonstration program, means to test technologies in a relevant environment or expected operational environment. A technology may require a specific demonstration:

- to gain flight heritage for potential commercial sales;
- for validation or qualification;
- for an eventual scientific experiment; and,
- to demonstrate a new product, service or application.

The questionnaire consists of twelve questions to assess your technology demonstration needs and obtain your opinion on a proposed framework of a model of Technology Demonstration initiative.
