#### **Humanities and Social Sciences**

- Pierre Chauveau Medal
  - Awarded for a distinguished contribution to knowledge in the Humanities
- Jason A. Hannah Medal\*
  - Awarded for an important publication in the history of medicine. \*(Different criteria for this medal, please refer to RSC Nomination Guide [11])
- Yvan Allaire Medal (+ \$5,000)
  - For outstanding contribution in governance (Social Sciences)

### **Sciences**

- Henry Marshall Tory Medal
  - Awarded for outstanding research in any branch of astronomy, chemistry, mathematics, physics, or an applied science
- McLaughlin Medal
  - For important research of sustained excellence in any branch of medical sciences
- Miroslaw Romanowsk Medal (+ \$3,000)
  - Awarded for contributions towards the resolution of scientific aspects of environmental problems or for important improvements to the quality of an ecosystem in all aspects - terrestrial, atmospheric and aqueous - brought about by scientific means
- Rutherford Memorial Medals (one in Chemistry and one in Physics)
  - For research in chemistry or physics
  - Preference will be given to candidates under forty years old
