Description

The goal of the Pilot Award is to provide early support for exploratory ideas, particularly those with novel hypotheses. Appropriate projects for this mechanism include those considered higher risk but with the potential for transformative results. In particular, encouraged applications are those that propose research to link genetic or other autism spectrum disorder (ASD) risk factors to molecular, cellular, circuit or behavioral mechanisms of ASD. Eligibility

All applicants and key collaborators must hold a PhD, MD or equivalent degree and have a faculty position or the equivalent at a college, university, medical school or other research facility. In addition, eligible applicants must have independent lab space at their institution. There are no citizenship or country requirements.

PIs may submit one Pilot Award and one Research Award application per academic year. Unfunded Pilot applications may not be resubmitted in consecutive cycles (e.g., if an application is submitted in response to the Winter 2019 Pilot Award request for applications (RFA), the next eligibility for resubmission would be for the Winter 2020 Pilot Award RFA. Similarly, if an application is submitted in response to the Summer 2019 Pilot Award RFA, the next eligibility would be for the Summer 2020 Pilot Award RFA).
