Description

Exchange Grants (formerly "Travel grants") are intended to subsidize the cost of travel required to support national and international knowledge mobilization within and/or beyond the research community. It is the expectation that applicants who receive a Exchange grant will apply for an external SSHRC grant (any program) within three years of the end of their Exchange grant.

Exchange grants are not available to reimburse travel expenses/claims which have occurred in the past. The proposed dates of travel for February 2019 competition will fall between March 1 - September 30, 2019.

Eligibility

All regular faculty members, including probationary, tenured and contractually-limited term appointees, are eligible. Contractually-limited term applicants and postdoctoral fellows are eligible, provided they are employed under a contract with the University for a period sufficiently long to make it feasible to carry out the proposed research project and/or travel. Professors emeriti are also eligible for this program. Visiting fellows and scholars are not eligible.

Successful applicants who receive SIG-Exchange funding are expected to apply to an external SSHRC grant competition within three (3) years of the end date of their SIG-Exchange.

Maximum Project Value

\$1,500 will be made to successful applicants in any one calendar year. Applicants may only

submit one (1) application in each competition, but a single application might cover **a number of activities all leading to the development of one (1) external SSHRC application**. Exchange funds awarded are to be spent within 60 days after the date of the conference or award date (whichever is later). Funds not utilized within this 60-day period will be recalled.
