On behalf of the University of Guelph, the Research Services Office, Research Innovation Office, and College Research Managers from CEPS, OAC, OVC and CBS, we are pleased to have **Louisa Ho, Research and Innovation Development Officer from NSERC** join us on **Tuesday, March 19th** to provide an overview of the NSERC Alliance grants and their recent program updates.

In 2022–23, NSERC evaluated the program through surveys, consultations and interviews with stakeholders, including U of G faculty and staff. The perspective of the community along with NSERC's experience to date shaped the [changes described in their news release](#), including:

- New names for cost sharing options
- Broadening the range of partner organizations recognized for cost sharing
- Conflict of interest guidelines
- Streamlined merit criteria
- Cost sharing vouchers for early career researchers
- Other improvements for early career researchers

These changes aim to make the Alliance grants program even more simple, flexible, modernized and responsive. They will help to:

- remove barriers to collaboration
- champion more research partnerships
- provide efficient and responsive proposal assessment
- strengthen relationships with the research community
- ensure inclusive research support
