Description

FCRF aims to accomplish the following objectives:

- Support developing new expert partnerships between France and Canada;
- Promote the advancement of research and innovation;
- Prepare and structure scientific cooperation between the two countries;
- Promote researcher mobility, particularly for young researchers; and
- Provide research training for young researchers.

This program provides financing for new scientific projects jointly developed by French and Canadian teams that have never worked together before.

Eligibility

Joint projects between a French establishment (all universities, Grandes Ecoles and research organizations are eligible) and Canadian Member universities.

Funding Availability

The financing is awarded to two-year projects in amounts ranging from \$8,000 to \$15,000, according to the needs expressed by lead researchers. Financing is primarily intended to support the mobility of researchers and their students.
