Description

Shastri Indo-Canadian Institute has announced a call for applications for Faculty Training and Internationalization program (FTI) from faculty members in all disciplines. Eligibility

Funding Availability

\$5,000 CAD. The grant includes a round-trip economy class airfare from Canada to the city of affiliated institutions in India and a weekly/monthly stipend as per the travel policy of the Institute.

Project implementation period starts from November 15, 2016 and ends on September 30, 2017.
