## Description

For a limited time, graduate students at Canadian universities, and Masters and PhD students at Sorbonne Universities can apply for a competitive Mitacs Globalink Research Award to support a research project jointly supervised by Canadian and Sorbonne University faculty.

# Eligibility

# **Funding Availability**

Canadian students receive up to\$5,000 for travel and project related costs such as: visa reimbursements, return airfare and health insurance. A limited number of awards are available.

# **Project Duration**

12 – 24 weeks at Sorbonne Universities for Canadian students. Projects can begin as early as June 1, 2015 and as a late as December 31, 2015.
