What Constitutes a Minor Amendment

Guideline

The Director, Animal Care Services, or his/her designate, can approve a minor amendment, at his/her discretion, on behalf of the Animal Care Committee.

Such changes would include but are not limited to:

- source of animal and disposition (e.g. adoption, transferred to another AUP, sale, method of euthanasia, returned to owner/source)
- location of animal accommodation or experimental area
- personnel (addition and/or removal)
- minor changes in procedures e.g. tail vein to saphenous vein, change in anaesthetic or analgesic drug, dosage or route of administration
- certain changes in numbers
- changes in assessment sheets (endorsed by the Designated Veterinarian)

Administrative changes: ACS may add renewed/new grants, new permits and other relevant documents at any time without prospective/retrospective approval by the ACC.
