Appointment of Community Members on the Animal Care Committee

Guideline

The following might be appropriate to consider when choosing a "community member" for the Animal Care Committee (ACC):

1. An interest in and/or a general understanding of research ("open-minded").
2. An active participant in planning/organization/supporting affairs in the Guelph community **and/or** a member or an active participant in the affairs of the Guelph Humane Society or an Animal Welfare Group.
3. Primary members should be able to attend the majority of the meetings of the ACC.
4. Should be appointed by the Research Services Council on the recommendation of the ACC for a one year term, subject to renewal.
5. Should have the full privileges of a Committee Member.
6. Must be able to devote time to activities of the ACC beyond the regular meetings (reading protocols, site-visits, etc.).
7. Should receive no remuneration other than that deemed appropriate by the ACC (expenses, etc.).
