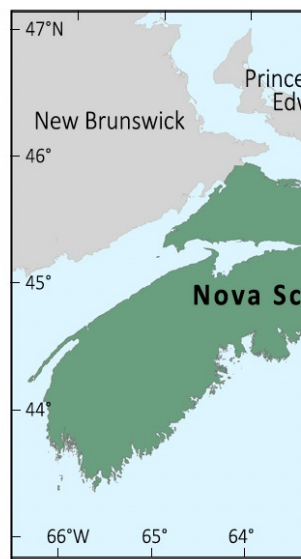

Piktukowaq Environmental Health Interpretive Framework

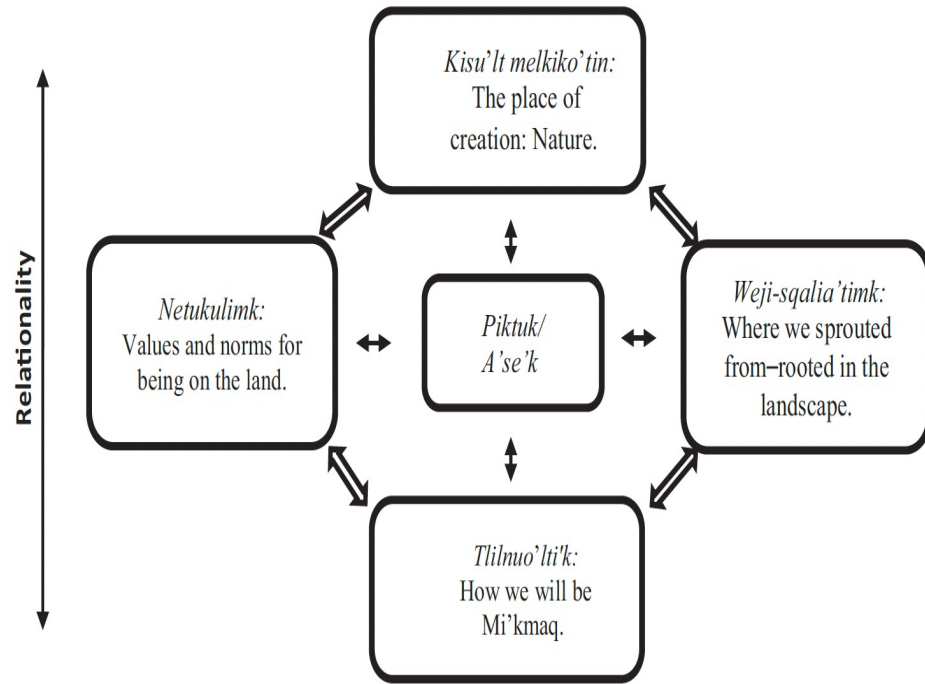

Piktukowaq ways of being.

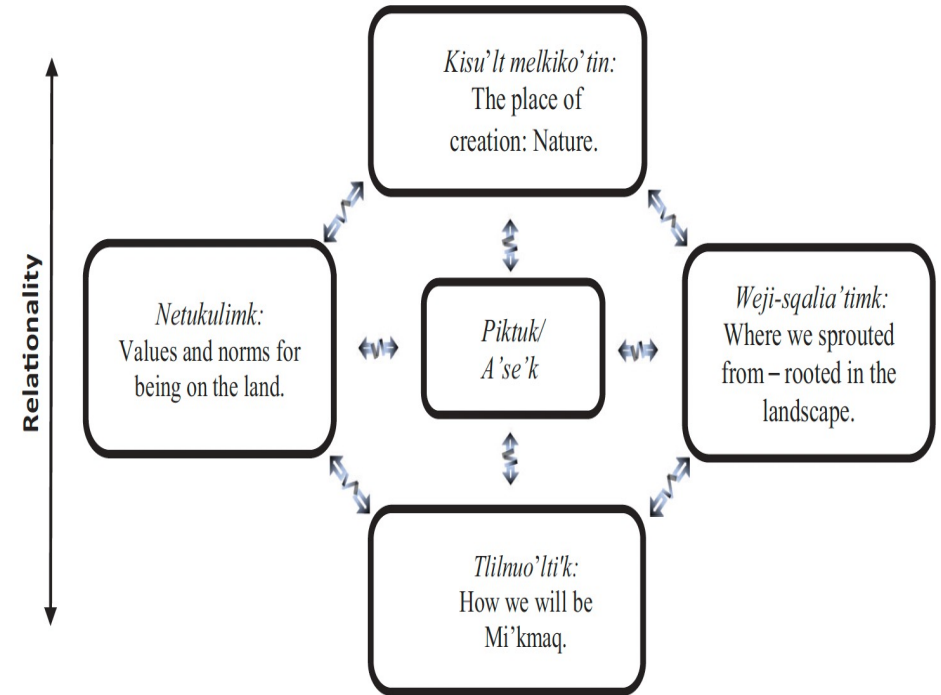
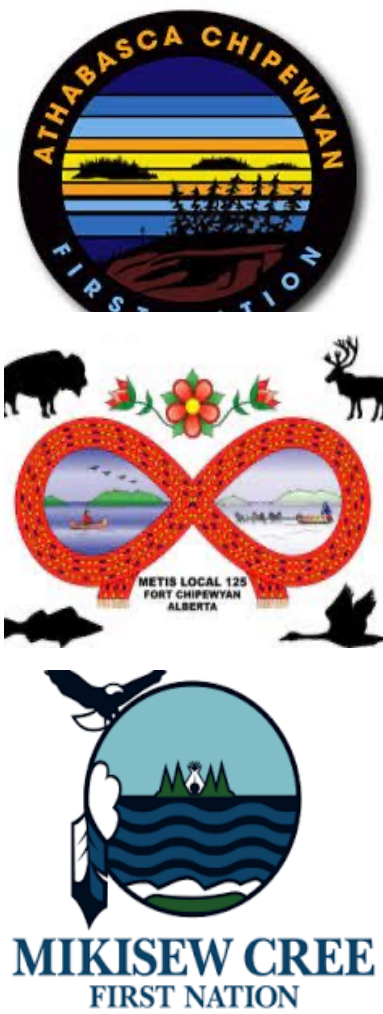
